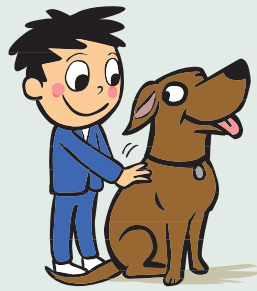




How Kids SHOULD Interact with Dogs

Be polite and kind to pets

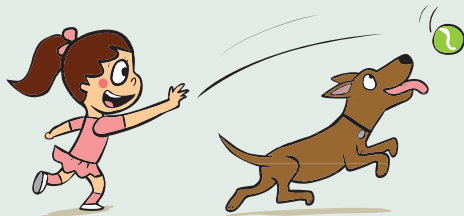


Learn to recognize when your dog is scared or anxious

Fetch



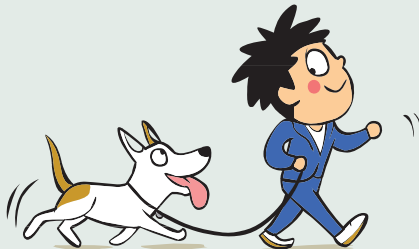
ROLL OVER



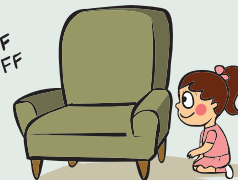
Training tricks (like roll over, shake, beg, etc.)

Playing hide-n-seek

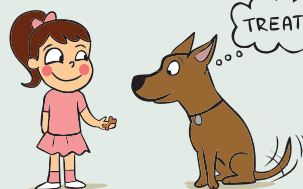


Always remember:
